It is best to learn to lip-read with other people and a lip-reading class is a good way to develop relevant skills, to improve confidence and to do something positive and practical about your hearing loss.

The North Berwick lip-reading group meets on Wednesday mornings during school term-time for 2 hours in North Berwick Community Centre. The class is very informal and friendly. There are around a dozen members in the class and new members would be made most welcome.
